1.5.3 Weight Categories

Organizer can combine the categories to only the next category if the number of participants in a category is not sufficient, then the medal of the higher category is awarded.

1.6 Competition Rules

1.6.1 Competition System

The system of the competition rules :

- > for 3 or 4 athletes, there will be a round - robin
- > for 5 or more athletes, there will be an elimination system with double repechage
- > for 2 or less athletes the category will be joined to the closer age category at the discretion of the IJF sports director.

1.6.2 Golden Score Rules

There will be no Golden Score after the fight ends in a draw. The result will be decided by the referee and two judges who will indicate the winner by raising the appropriate coloured flag. This will be indicated on the contest sheet as a " Hantei " win.

1.6.3 The competitions will be held in white and blue judogi. Judogi markings must be in accordance with the IJF regulations and previous back numbers must be removed.

Note: All competitors can wear personal back numbers. They can buy the official World Championships back number in advance.

The women competitor must wear a white non-transparent t-shirt. The bra must not have any hard pieces.

Long hair has to be bound with an elastic band.

Make-up and jewellery are prohibited. The nails have to be cut short.

The competition of each category will take place on one day.



1.6.4 Team Event

A team can be nominated until Saturday, 30th May 2009, 11:00 hrs.

All teams may nominate one reserve-competitor per weight category who may only be used to replace an injured competitor in the same weight category. Each competitor may only compete in one team at the World Championships.

If a team is submitted no additional competitor will be permitted to enter the team.

Different teams of one country are labeled Team 1, Team 2...

All teams are allowed to have one guest competitor. That means any competitor from a country other the actual country that the team represents.

1.6.5 Participation

The IJF would like to keep these event open to all nations affiliated to the IJF. Each competitor must be a member of one of these national federations.

The athlete can be entered only in one weight category in which he is enrolled.

The competitor must be minimum 30 years and with no competition in the last 3 years in the national or international official IJF judo events.

Competitors who have double nationality can represent only one country.

1.6.6 Entries

The entry has to be made from a national federation or national club or an individual athlete to the German Judo Federation before the deadline of the 7th of May 2009.

Entries are only accepted if the entry fee is paid before the deadline.



1.6.7 Entry Fee

The entry fee has to be paid to the German Judo Federation in the moment the entry is made. A return of the entry fee is not possible.

The entry fee of 100 EUR per participating competitor must be paid before 7th of May 2009. 24 hours after the deadline the entries will also be published on the official homepage.

For the team-event the entry fee is 100 EUR per team. Team entries are possible during the competition. If you make the team entry after the deadline you have to pay 150 EUR per team. No entries are possible after the 30th May, 11:00 hrs.

1.6.8 PREMIUM Fees

Premium competition fees

Each competitor can choose to take a special package of the PREMIUM-Competition Fee which includes:

- one T-Shirt of the event
- one certificate of the event
- one Lanyard/pin
- one special event gift.

For this package you have to pay 40,00 EUR before the 7th of May 2008. Of course you can buy these things on the spot for 50,00 EUR.

PREMIUM back-numbers

Each competitor can choose to take a set of two back-numbers including name, federation and the title "World Championships for Masters Sindelfingen" for the total prize of 30,00 EUR. You have to buy this set of back-numbers in advance together with the inscription.

1.6.9 Inscription

A. Inscription of the federation:

An inscription of all participating federations must arrive at the **IJF secretariat** and the **DJB (organizer)** before the **30th of March 2009**. Only members of those Federations who had made this inscription can take part in this event.

B. Inscription of each competitor:

A final nominative inscription must be sent to the **IJF secretariat** and to the **DJB (organizer)** until the 7th of May 2009.



This includes individual and team inscription. There will be no individual entry after the deadline but in the team event, entries are possible until the 30th of May at the accreditation-office in the venue.

1.6.10 Weigh-in

The weigh-in takes place on the day before the competition day after the announced times, as the competition for the category concerned. The weight of the fighters has to fall within the category in which they are enrolled.

The fighters:

- Presenting themselves after the closing of the weigh-in, cannot participate at competition.
- Must present their accreditation and an official piece of identity (identity card or passport) at the official weigh-in.

The weigh-in will be held at the competition hall.

1.6.10 Draw

The draw will take place at the evening before every category competition day.

Note: before the draw the lists of each category are hung in the draw room / in the corridor outside the draw room each head of delegation should check that all his inscribed athletes are on these lists and that they are under the right category. No corrections can be made after the draw.

1.6.11 Accreditation

Each competitor has to go personally to the accreditation-office. It will be open:

Each competitor has to show his individual passport and to check his entry.
After this he will receive his accreditation and an entry ticket for his/her coach. If the competitor wants to have an additional accreditation card for officials he has to pay 20,00 EUR for the whole event (instead of the coach entry ticket).

1.6.12 Responsibility of the competitor

- a) Medical certificate
The sex certificate and the medical certificate of each competitor are not required. All competitors will compete on their own responsibility.
- b) Insurance
Each fighter is responsible for insuring himself against injury and third part risk (public liability) during the period of the championships.

The International Judo Federation and its organizer the German Judo Federation (including the Württembergischer Judo-Verband) decline all responsibility.

1.6.13 Anti-Doping

No anti-doping control tests are done during the championships.



2. Refereeing Information (FOR National Federations)

2.1 Level of the referees

All referees who want to participate in these Championships have to have an international A or B level of the IJF.

2.2 Inscription

Each federation has to enter at least one referee. Only the referees entered by their Federation can referee. The costs for travelling, board and lodging of the referees are at the costs of the member federation.

Participating federations not entering a referee have to pay 600,00 EUR. Inscriptions have to be sent to the organizer (DJB) before the 7th of May 2009.

2.3 Referee Meeting

A referee meeting is scheduled the evening before the first competition day on Wednesday, the 27th of May 2009 at 19.00 o'clock at the competition hall. The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory.
