Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation	<b>5 Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation</b> Comp Dev context version. Use Comp-Int version if Comp Dev is not available.
Formal Evaluation	<b>6 Evaluation of a Submitted Portfolio</b> > Coach Judo Resume - Rank, athletes trained, level of coaching, competitors and results > Self-assessments on Competition Development training > Three sample microcycles and practice plans from within YPI season > Plan for development of one specified technical skill > Plan for development of one specified tactical skill > Plan for development of one specified athletic ability > Plan for development of one specified mental skill The documentation will be reviewed by designated facilitator or evaluator and the recommendations will be ratified by a Judo Canada staff.
