

2017 JUNIOR & CADET PAN-AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIPS
(Cancun, Mexico, 1-2 July 2017)

INTRODUCTION

These selection procedures apply to cadet (U18) and junior (U21) weight categories recognized by the International Judo Federation (IJF).

CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Canadian citizenship is a prerequisite to be selected for the 2017 JUNIOR & CADET PAN-AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIPS.

SELECTION PROCEDURES – CADET (U18)

The PJC will set the quotas per weight category. The selection will be based on the following priorities:

1st priority: Cadet World Championships Team members

2nd priority: Winners (gold medalists) of the Cadet National championships 2017 (May 26, 2017) will be selected, quota permitting. If there is a need to prioritize between gold medalists, this will be done on the basis of their National Team Points at the selection deadline, as per Policies 3, 4 & 6 of the National Team Handbook 2016-2017.

3rd priority: Should quota places still be left open after application of priorities 1 and 2, these remaining places will be filled on the basis of the National Team Points at the selection deadline, as per Policies 3, 4 & 6 of the National Team Handbook 2016-2017.

SELECTION PROCEDURES – JUNIOR (U21)

The PJC will set the quotas per weight category. The selection will be based on those priorities:

1st priority: The winners (gold medalists) of the Junior National championships 2017 (May 27, 2017) will be selected.

2nd priority: For the rest of the quotas, athletes with the most National team points (Policies 3, 4 & 6 of the National Team Handbook 2016-2017) at the selection deadline will be selected.

CONDITION OF SELECTION

- 1) Participation at the Cadet or Junior Nationals 2017 is mandatory (unless granted medical exemption)
- 2) Participation in the national camp following the 2017 Nationals is mandatory (unless granted medical exemption or being selected by Judo Canada for another event)

FUNDING CRITERIA

For Junior Athletes:

The Junior Pan-American Championships are not a priority this year for Judo Canada, as they interfere with European preparation events for the Junior team. Therefore, no funding will be awarded for participation in the Junior Pan-American Championships.

For Cadet Athletes:

The Cadet Pan-American Championships represent a last competitive event in the preparation for the Cadet World Championships, and funding will be awarded for participation in the Cadet Pan-American Championships, as follows:

- 1) 100% funded: Athletes with "E" standard" (or above) valid at the time of the event.
- 2) Partially funded (budget permitting): athletes with "F standard" valid at the time of the event.
