# 2019 CADET & JUNIOR PAN-AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

(Cali, Colombia, 19-20 July 2019) Selection date: May 27, 2019

#### **INTRODUCTION**

These selection procedures apply to cadet (U18) and junior (U21) weight categories recognized by the International Judo Federation.

#### **CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENTS**

Canadian citizenship is a prerequisite to be selected for the 2019 CADET & JUNIOR PAN-AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIPS.

# SELECTION PROCEDURES - CADET (U18)

The Pan-American Judo Confederation (PJC) will set the quotas per weight category. The selection will be based on the following priorities, as of May 27, 2019:

1st priority: 2019 Cadet World Team members, as per selection 1 for the 2019 Cadet World Championships, as described in the National Team Handbook 2018-2019.

 $\underline{2^{\text{nd}}}$  priority: The quota places still left open after the application of priority 1 will be filled based on the National Team Points at the selection deadline, as per policies 3, 4 & 6 of the National Team Handbook 2018-2019.

 $\underline{3^{rd}}$  priority: Winners (gold medallists) of the Cadet National Championship 2019 (May 17, 2019) will be selected.

#### **SELECTION PROCEDURES – JUNIOR (U21)**

The PJC will set the quotas per weight category. The selection will be based on the following priorities:  $\underline{\mathbf{1}}^{\text{st}}$  priority: 2019 Cadet World Team members, as per selection 1 for the 2019 Cadet World Championships, as described in the National Team Handbook 2018-2019.

 $2^{nd}$  priority: The quota places still left open after the application of priority 1 will be filled based on the National Team Points at the selection deadline, as per policies 3, 4 & 6 of the National Team Handbook 2018-2019.

# **CONDITION OF SELECTION**

- 1) Participation at the Cadet or Junior Nationals 2019 in Edmonton, Alberta, (*May 17-18, 2019*) is mandatory (unless granted medical exemption).
- 2) Participation in the national camp following the 2019 Nationals (*May 20-22, 2019*) is mandatory (unless granted medical exemption or being selected by Judo Canada for another event).
- 3) Participation at the Canada Cup 2019 (*June 28-29, 2019, Montréal*) and camp (*July 1-4, 2019*) following the event is mandatory.

### **FUNDING CRITERIA**

For Junior Athletes: No funding for Juniors for this event.

# For Cadet Athletes:

Funding will be awarded for participation in the Cadet Pan-American Championships as follows:

- 1) 100% funded: athletes with a valid "D" standard (or above) at the time of the event.
- 2) Partially funded (budget permitting): athletes with a valid "E" standard at the time of the event.
